To identify, along with community participation, psychosocial and mental health needs in various sites in Pakistan

To perform psychosocial and mental health assessment using following methodology: interviews, observation, surveys and focus groups

Lead activities that address the emotional and psychological needs of the affected communities through primary social interventions

To submit timely reports on performed assessment to Country director and Headquarters

To develop a good relationship with MoH, local health authorities, INGOs, WHO and a local community

To attend various psychosocial and mental health coordination meetings important for the assessment

To collect information important for the assessment from all relevant sources, e.g. community, health professionals, health authorities, INGOs and UN organizations

To work according to ethical international guidelines and incorporate indigenous healing systems into the approach

To report on relevant and appropriate psychosocial and mental health activities for IMC to undertake in Pakistan

To develop project proposals integrated with other aspects of IMCs mental health work as requested by country director

Work with all stakeholders to ensure cooperation and coordination, share information and create effective joint response and sustainable program activities.
