### About the Day

The Forum is an opportunity for everyone involved with Therapeutic Communities and Therapeutic Environments to reflect on practice, exchange ideas and support each other to develop and strengthen the approach.

This year the focus is on outcomes. What do we measure, how do we measure it and what is a successful outcome? Are our responses to external demands different to what matters to service users? What are the values behind collecting this evidence of outcomes, and can we expect a positive outcome from having core standards based on explicit values?

**Professor Bill Fulford** (Warwick University) and service users from communities across the network will provide the morning's keynote presentations.

Afternoon workshops are led by members of the Community of Communities who will share examples of practice, ideas and innovation.
