In Bridgend

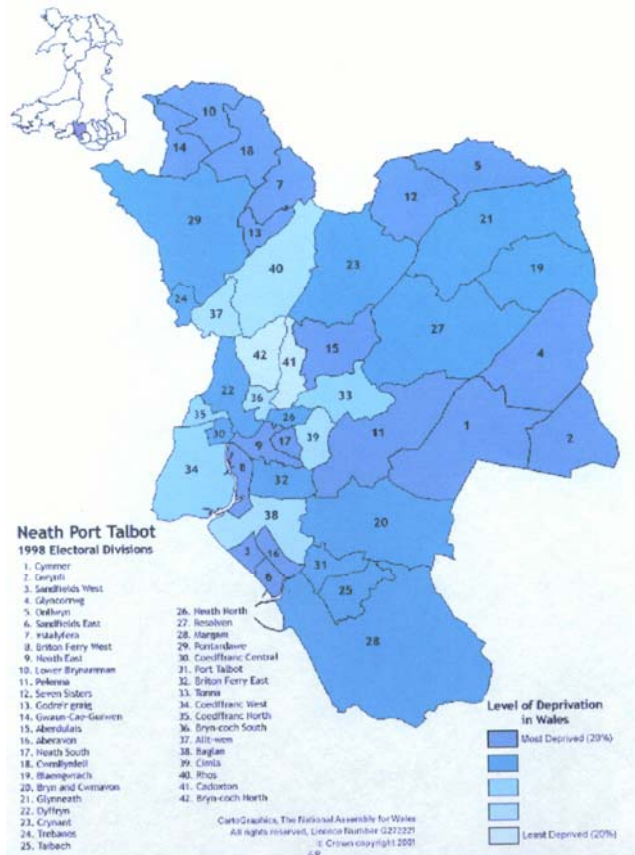
- half of the electoral divisions were more deprived than the average for Wales

scores in Wales range from 74.9 to 1.3



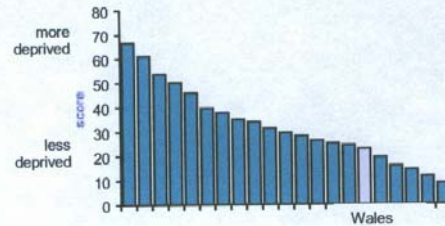
In Bridgend

- levels of deprivation were a little higher than in Wales as a whole for health and education

a representative cross-section showing the range of scores within the authority

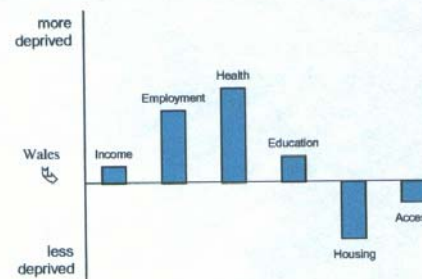


In Neath Port Talbot

- three quarters of the electoral divisions were more deprived than the average for Wales
- the most deprived electoral division was Cymmer with a score of 66.6

scores in Wales range from 74.9 to 1.3

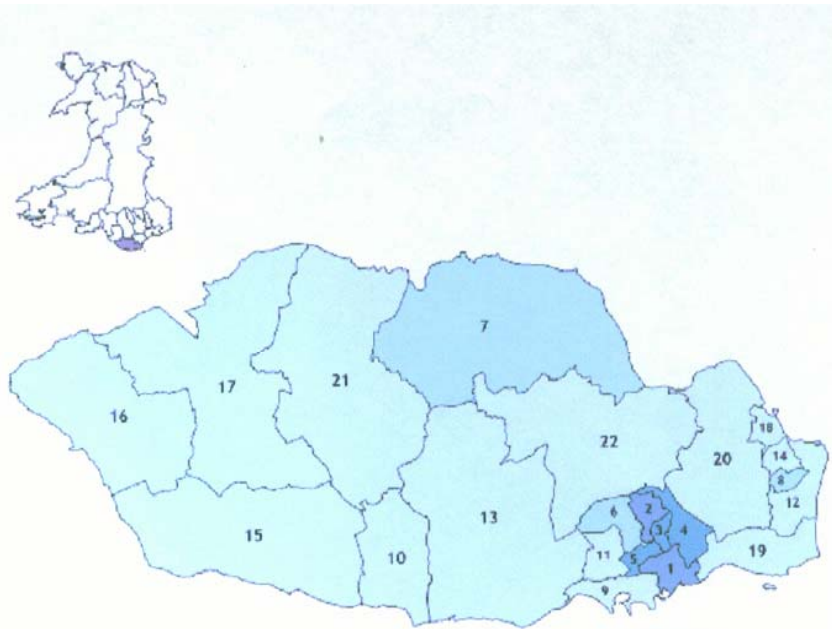
level of domain deprivation in Neath Port Talbot relative to Wales



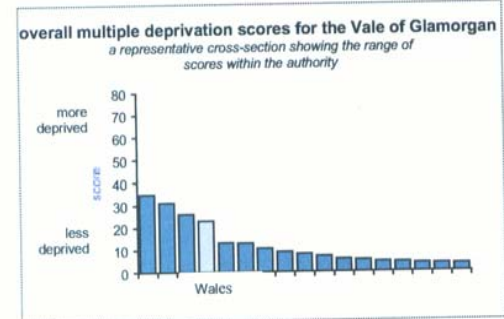
In Neath Port Talbot

- levels of deprivation were much higher than in Wales as a whole for health, and higher for employment, and (to a lesser extent) education and income

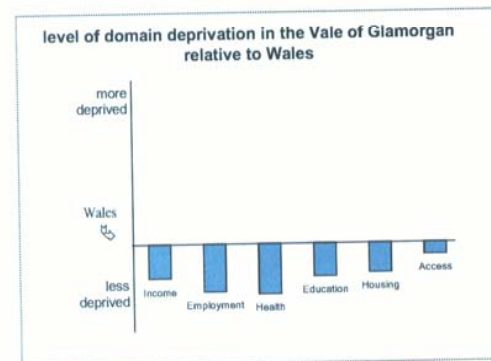
Vale of Glamorgan



The Vale of Glamorgan



- just under a quarter of the electoral divisions were more deprived than the average for Wales
- the most deprived electoral division was Castleland with a score of 34.7
scores in Wales range from 74.9 to 1.3



In the Vale of Glamorgan

- levels of deprivation were not higher than in Wales as a whole for any domain

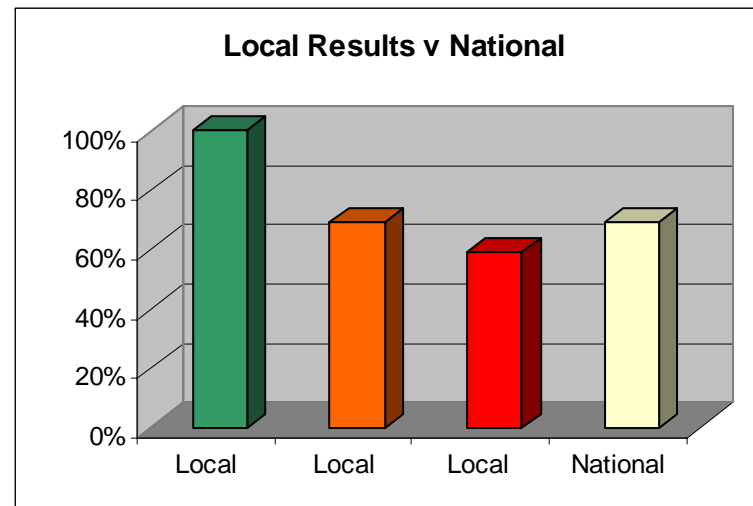

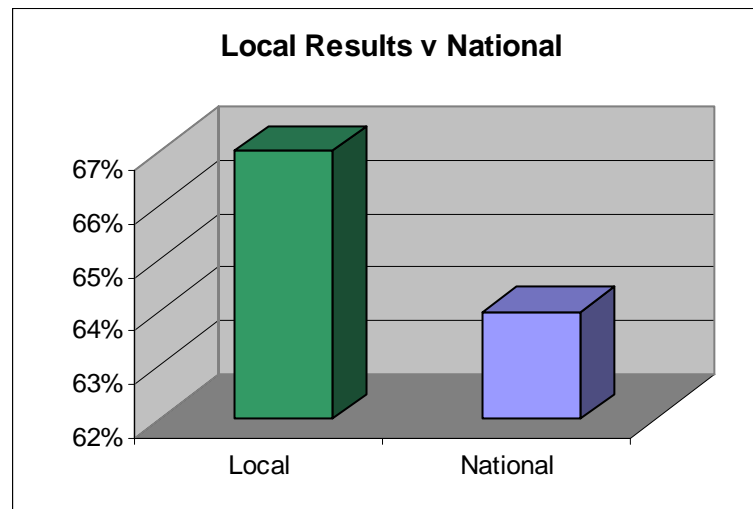

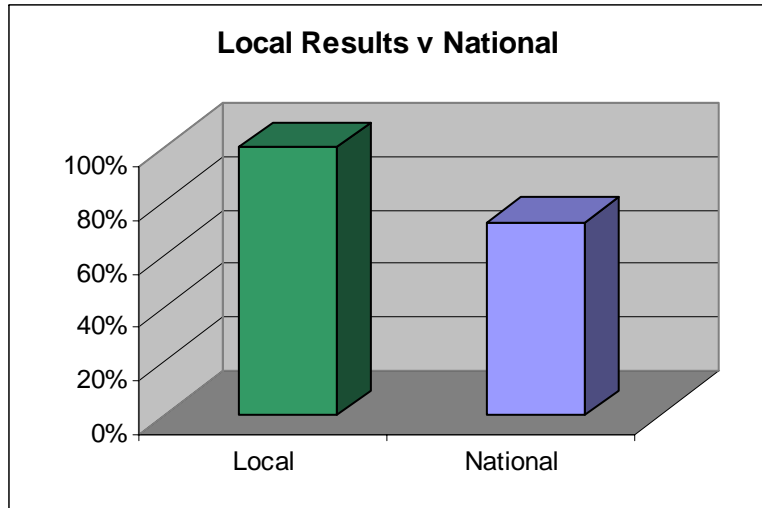


Oral medication should be offered before parental medication



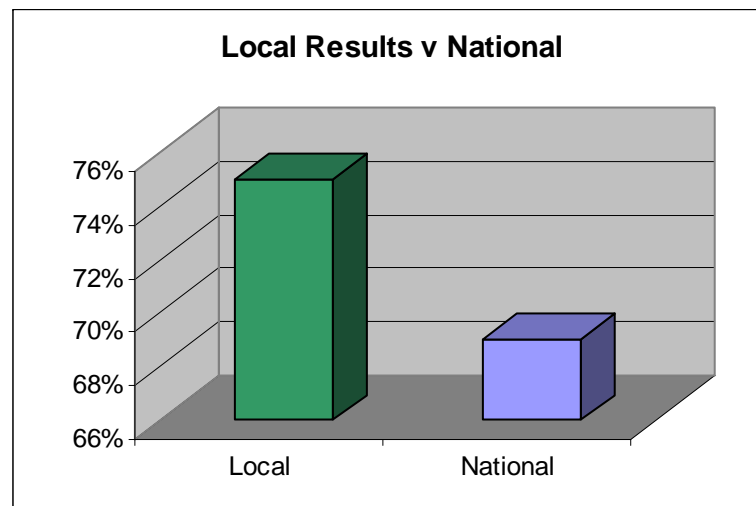


Are oral and IM medications written up separately on the Drug Charts ?



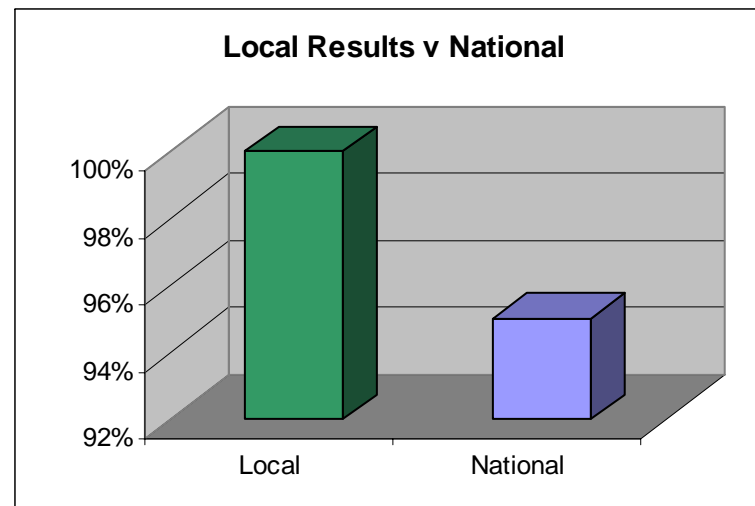


Was an oral antipsychotic given in combination with oral Lorazepam initially?



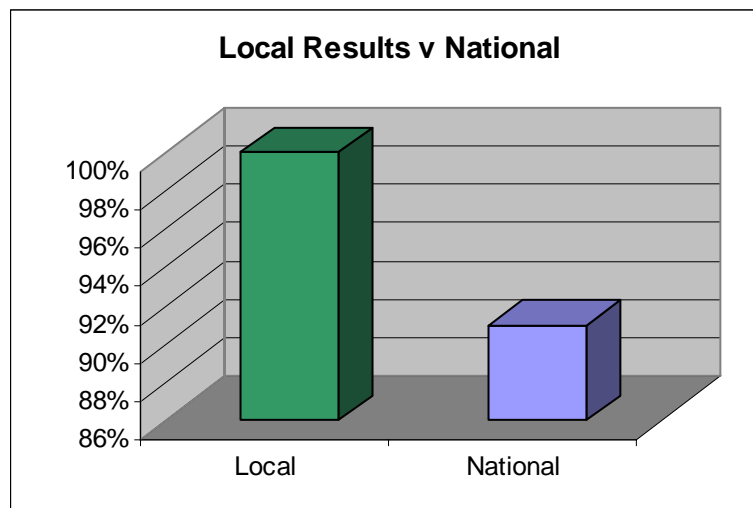


Was sufficient time allowed for clinical response between oral doses of medication?



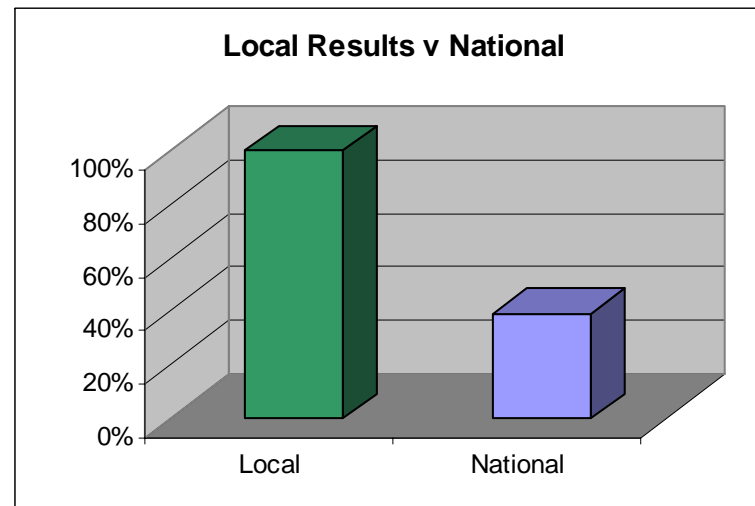


Was intramuscular medication offered in preference to intravenous medication?
