

Intensive Psychiatric Care Units (IPCUs) Project



Project update/summary
June 2009

Background and Purpose

Intensive psychiatric care units (IPCUs) are addressed in NHS Quality Improvement Scotland's (NHS QIS) 3-year strategic work programme, Improving the Quality of Mental Health Services, 2005–2008, where NHS QIS makes a commitment to undertake an audit of IPCUs in Scotland. In addition, the Scottish Government Health Directorates (SGHD) mental health benchmarking study (2008) recommended that NHS boards standardise their definitions of IPCUs.

Aims

To gather information on:

- the number of IPCUs across Scotland
- how the IPCUs are structured and staffed
- the relationships between IPCUs and other mental health inpatient units
- the referral pathways both in and out of IPCUs, and
- the user and carer experience of IPCUs.

Progress to date

- IPCU project clinical support recruited
- all NHS board areas have completed and returned service profile form(s)
- visits to all IPCUs in Scotland, and to NHS board areas that don't have IPCU provision, underway and due for completion mid-July 2009, and
- regular steering group and service user and carer group meetings to plan future work.

Planned outcomes

- all service profiling reports published winter 2009
- national overview report and report of the user and carer experience work published spring 2010 to include:
 - an overview of service provision and the relationships between services
 - identification of gaps in services
 - examples of good practice and innovative service delivery
 - recommendations for service development
- the service profiling work will inform stage 2 of the IPCU project.
