Rehabilitation accreditation summary

To get a CCT rehabilitation accreditation, higher trainees have to complete one year in a post where they can gain the appropriate competencies and values. The Regional Representative for the Rehabilitation Faculty will determine prospectively whether potential posts meet this criterion.

Where an individual has gained a CCT without rehabilitation accreditation they may apply to the Faculty for its recognition of competency in this field. The Faculty Education and Curriculum Committee Chairman will work with the Regional Representative on how and whether this can be granted. There is no legal process to add accreditations to existing CCTs but this will attest to rights to be accepted as a trainer in rehabilitation and may help with appointments committees. In such cases a letter that supports the person's competency in rehabilitation psychiatry can be provided by the Faculty Chair.
