**RESEARCH PRESENTATION PRIZE  
FOR  
TRAINEES AND SPECIALTY GRADE DOCTORS**

The Trent Division of the Royal College of Psychiatrists invites entries from trainee psychiatrists and specialty grade psychiatrists for the Research Presentation Prize. Please note that trainees and specialty grade psychiatrists working in any specialty or sub-specialty within the Trent Region are eligible to enter providing the research was conducted in the UK irrespective of whether it is/was part of another degree.

The prize (which can be shared) of £200 will be awarded for the best presentation of a piece of research carried out by a trainee or specialty grade doctor. The winner will also be presented with a certificate at the Trent Division Annual General Meeting.

Up to four entries will be selected by the Administering Committee as the most meritorious of those submitted and the entrants will be invited to present their research at the Trent Division Annual General Meeting. The Committee will take into account the quality of both the research and the presentation. Presentations will be limited to fifteen minutes, including at least five minutes for discussion.
