THE TRENT DIVISION RESEARCH PRESENTATION PRIZE

The Trent Division has established an annual prize for the best presentation of a piece of research relevant to any field of psychiatry by a trainee or specialty grade psychiatrist.

Prize: £200 plus certificate

Frequency: Annually

Eligible: Trainee and specialty grade psychiatrists working in any specialty or sub-specialty of psychiatry within the Trent Region are eligible to enter. Entrants will be eligible to compete for the Research Prize provided the research was conducted in the UK irrespective of whether it is/was part of another degree.

Where Presented: Trent Division Annual Meeting

Regulations:

- i. The prize will be awarded for the best presentation of a piece of research relevant to any field of psychiatry.
- ii. An administering committee will be established by the Trent Division each year. The panel will include two academics and two consultants working in any specialty or sub-specialty of psychiatry.
- iii. Four entries will be short-listed to present at the Trent Division Annual General Meeting. Those entries that are not shortlisted will be offered the chance to take part in the Trent Division Poster Presentation Prize at the AGM.

Closing Date: The Research Presentation Prize will be advertised throughout the Division each year and entries should be submitted by the 31st July.

THE TRENT DIVISION POSTER PRESENTATION PRIZES

The Trent Division has established annual prizes for the best poster presentations for audit/research by CT1-3 trainees and ST4-6 trainees (and specialty grade doctors).

Prize: £100 plus certificate (CT1-3)
£100 plus certificate (ST4-6/ specialty grade doctor)

Frequency: Annually

Eligible: Trainee and specialty grade psychiatrists working in any specialty or sub-specialty of psychiatry within the Trent Region are eligible to enter.

Where Presented: Trent Division Annual General Meeting

Regulations:

- i. Prizes will be awarded for the best poster presentation in each category relevant to any field of psychiatry.
- ii. A screening committee will determine the number of posters to be displayed and successful entrants will be invited to display their poster at the Trent Division Annual General Meeting where the winner will be decided.

Closing Date: The Poster Presentation Prize will be advertised throughout the Division each year and entries should be submitted by the 31st July.

THE TRENT DIVISION AUDIT PRIZE FOR FOUNDATION TRAINEES

The Trent Division has established a prize for the best audit by a Foundation Trainee working within the Division.

Prize: £100 plus certificate

Frequency: Annually

Eligible: Any FY Trainee working within the Trent Division who is also registered as an RCPsych Student Associate

Where presented: Trent Division Annual Meeting

Regulations:

- i. The prize will be awarded for the best audit relevant to any field of psychiatry.
- ii. Entrants should submit an abstract of their audit (approx. 500 words). The successful candidate will be expected to display their audit as a poster presentation at the Trent Division Annual Meeting.
- iii. Entries will be judged anonymously by a panel which will include two academics and two consultants working in any specialty or sub-specialty of psychiatry.

Closing date: The Audit Prize for FY Trainees will be advertised throughout the Division each year and entries should be submitted by 31st July.

THE TRENT DIVISION 'IMAGES OF PSYCHIATRY' PHOTO PRIZE

The Trent Division has established a prize for the best photo taken by any member of the Division, depicting mental health.

Prize: £25

Frequency: Annually

Eligible: Any member of the Trent Division

Where presented: Cheques will be posted to winners. All photos will be displayed on the Division's website, and in the Division's newsletter. The winning entry will be displayed at the Trent Division Annual Meeting and a cheque will be presented to the winner.

Regulations:

- i. Entrants should submit their photo electronically with an accompanying paragraph of 150-200 words.
- ii. Entries will be judged by the elected members of the Trent Division Executive Committee.

Closing date: The 'Images of Psychiatry' photo prize will be advertised on the Division's website and in the Division's newsletter throughout the year. Entries should be submitted by the end of August.

THE TRENT DIVISION MEDICAL STUDENT ELECTIVE PRIZE

The Trent Division has established an annual prize for the best medical student elective from each medical school in the Division.

Prize: 3 prizes available – one for each medical school in the Division
1st prize - £500 plus certificate
2 runner up prizes - £250 plus certificate each

Frequency: Annually

Eligible: Medical students studying at a Medical School within the Division who are also registered as RCPsych Student Associates.

Where presented: Trent Division Annual Meeting

Regulations:

- i. Entrants should submit an A4 typed sheet detailing their elective attachment and what they hope to achieve, along with their CV and a letter of support from the Head of Psychiatry and/or Dean of their Medical School. A letter of support from the Consultant Psychiatrist where the elective attachment will be undertaken confirming supervision arrangements will also be required.
- ii. The elective travel should take place within 6 months of the award. Prize winners should submit a written report (500-1000 words) on their experience within 8 weeks of completion of the elective, which will be published in the Trent Division newsletter and presented at the Trent Annual Meeting
- iii. Entries will be judged anonymously by a panel of two academics and two consultants working in any specialty or sub-specialty of psychiatry. The best entry from each Medical School will go forward to be judged as the final winner and two highly commended.

Closing date: The Medical Student Elective Prize will be advertised throughout the Division's Medical Schools each year and entries should be submitted by 31st December. Entries will be assessed by 1st February so electives can take place in the Spring.

THE TRENT DIVISION MEDICAL STUDENT PUBLIC SPEAKING PRIZE

The Trent Division has established an annual public speaking prize for medical students from medical schools within the Division. It is hoped that this prize will enhance attendance at the AGM and stimulate interest in psychiatry amongst medical students.

Prize: £200 plus certificates to be shared between the winning team. Two runner-up teams will receive £50 each and certificates of participation. All participants will receive complimentary admission to the Trent Division Annual Meeting.

Frequency: Annually

Eligible: Medical students studying at a Medical School within the Division who are also registered as RCPsych Student Associates. Each Medical School will be invited to enter a team of two people.

Where presented: Trent Division Annual Meeting

Regulations:

- i. The topic for the competition will be determined by a sub-committee of the Trent Division Executive Committee in January/February each year.
- ii. Medical students wishing to enter should do so via their Medical School. Three teams of two people will be permitted, one per Medical School within the Division.
- iii. At the Trent Division Annual Meeting each team of two will speak for seven minutes on the pre-agreed topic without the use of visual aids. The team will be judged as a unit. A panel of three pre-determined judges will contribute 50% of the votes; the remaining 50% will come from the audience.

Closing date: The Medical Student Public Speaking Prize will be advertised throughout the Division's Medical Schools and on the Division's website in March each year and teams should be confirmed by 31st July. The Public Speaking competition will take place at the Trent Division Annual Meeting in October.
