## Psychiatry Silver Guide

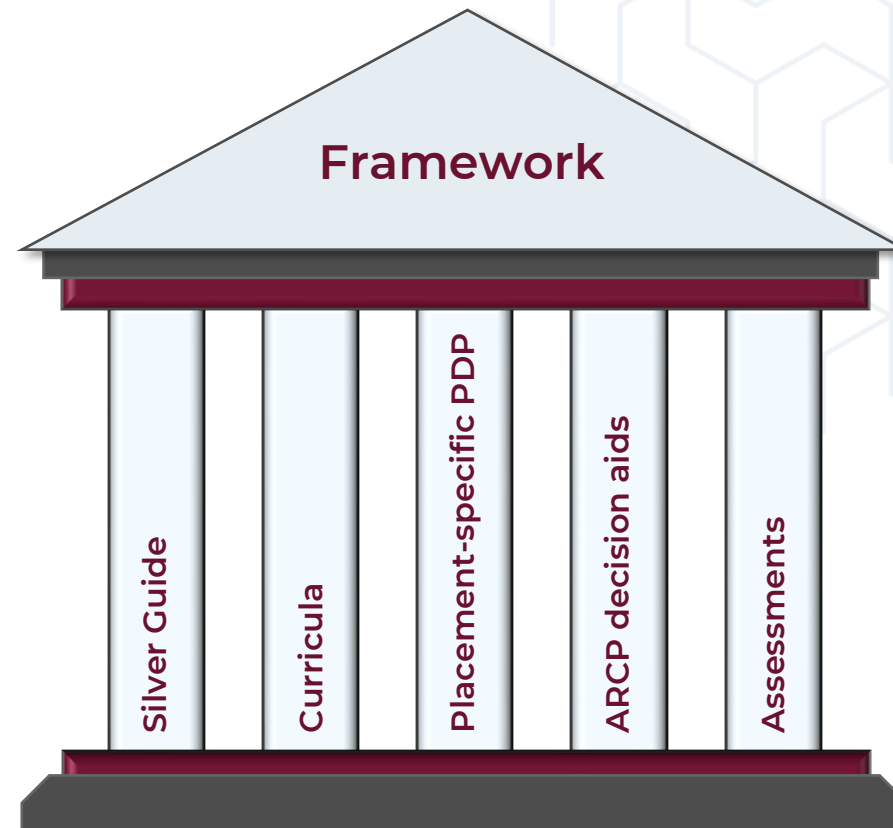
- Overarching guide to training in psychiatry

## Curricula

- Core, specialty and sub-specialty curricula.

## Placement-specific PDPs

- Map activities and evidence to HLOs



## ARCP guidance statements & decision aids

- Support ARCP panels to sign off trainee progression

## Assessments

- Formative (WPBAs) and summative (exam) assessments throughout training.

# Pilot

- Pilot is underway with approx 300 CT1 and ST4 trainees and their supervisors
- Quantitative survey sent out end of April
- Limited responses – encouragement welcome!
- Early responses show some struggles with Portfolio Online
- BUT – 65% of trainees rate supervisor conversations re. PDPs good / very good
- Deanery and Welcome event comms most helpful for trainees

# Placement-specific PDPs



- 60% of pilot cohort has posted activities in the new placement-specific PDP system
- Looking at reasons why 40% have not as yet used them
- Further communications to be sent out regarding this
- Appreciate being able to access the PS report will likely help with engagement given this

# Psychiatric Supervision Report



- Psychiatric Supervision Report to be released in next couple of weeks in Portfolio Online given need to be completed soon
- Created from information within placement-specific PDP – once all end of training evaluations have been made (and comments added)
- Will auto-populate with evaluations for each HLO and any relevant comments
- Considerable time-saving
- Only Clinical Supervisor who undertakes Psychiatric Supervision able to amend PSR

# ARCP guidance statements

- GMC seeking understanding of how we achieve parity of standards across all trainees across the UK
  - Trainers have also been requesting this in the weekly 'drop-in' sessions
- Explored several approaches
- Core Psychiatry draft has been produced
- Intention to provide example statements to describe the behaviours of a trainee meeting the expected standard for each HLO theme for CT1, 2, 3 etc



# Example draft statement

HLO	Themes
3.1	<b>Knowledge of legal and organisational frameworks in your UK jurisdiction</b>  Apply advanced knowledge of relevant legislative frameworks across the UK to safeguard patients.
Year	Behaviour typical of trainees meeting the expected standard

<b>CT1</b>	<b>The trainee consistently:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Identifies those sections of mental health and Capacity / Incapacity legislation that are relevant to their patients and knows how they are applied</li></ul> <b>Supervision</b> Under regular supervision
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<b>CT2</b>	<b>The trainee consistently:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Understands the legislation in the wider legal context, for example the Human Rights Act</li><li>Delivers least restrictive care, balancing this with the need to ensure the safety of their patients and others</li></ul> <b>Supervision</b> Under regular supervision
<b>CT3</b>	<b>The trainee consistently:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Understands and applies Mental Health and Capacity / Incapacity legislation in clinical practice with increasing autonomy to ensure readiness for statutory approval</li></ul> <b>Supervision</b> Under regular supervision
