Brief refresher

Prevalence c2.5%

M:F 2-3:1

ID:No-ID 1:2

Heritability c80%

Characterised by significant differences in social communication and restricted and repetitive behaviours and interests

Social Communication

Social emotional reciprocity, Non-verbal communication and developing and maintaining relationships

RRBIs

Intense interests, sensory processing, routine and rituals, stereotyped behaviours

Autism association with mental illness

Higher rates of:

- Psychosis
- OCD
- PTSD
- Mood disorders
- Substance misuse
- Suicide

Up to 20% of outpatient referrals to psychiatry

Mental health of autistic women

Late diagnosis associated with higher rates of all mental illnesses except schizophrenia

Women are typically diagnosed later

High levels of masking are associated with worse mental health

Women typically mask more

Women have high levels of missed diagnosis and misdiagnosis – especially EUPD

Mental health of autistic women

Autistic women have higher rates of:

- Mental health diagnosis
- Psychiatric hospitalisation
- Death in hospital
- Suicide

Than non-autistic women and autistic men

Perinatal health of autistic women

Higher rates of:

- Pre-eclampsia
- Pre-term birth
- Unplanned caesarean section
- Antenatal depression
- Postnatal depression

Barriers to accessing healthcare

Autistic women report worse experiences of antenatal and postnatal care

Researchers devised a tool for measuring healthcare accessibility

Differences between autistic and nonautistic participants could be used to screen for autism with 94% sensitivity and 72% accuracy.

Conception

Autistic people are almost as likely to be having sex as non autistic people (and possibly more risky sex)

Autistic women have higher rates of endometriosis and PCOS — may have issues conceiving Conception as a mini special interest

Antenatal Care

Lots of appointments can be overwhelming

Keep things as consistent as possible

Think about sensory environment

Interplay of anxiety, vagueness, pattern recognition and interoception around foetal movements

Labour

Differences in nociception

Differences in communicating pain

Prior discussions helpful

Postnatal care

Minimise time on the ward

Side room if possible

Accept idiosyncrasy

Give them permission to be autistic

Motherhood



Being autistic does not predict an inability to bond with or take cues from one's baby

Bonding with and taking cues from one's baby does not go against an autism diagnosis



Key points

Autism is associated with an increased risk of mental health problems and suicide

Late diagnosis is associated with increased risk, as is masking

Autistic people face significant inequalities around healthcare access

The perinatal journey can present challenges to autistic women, many of which can be overcome with simple adjustments
