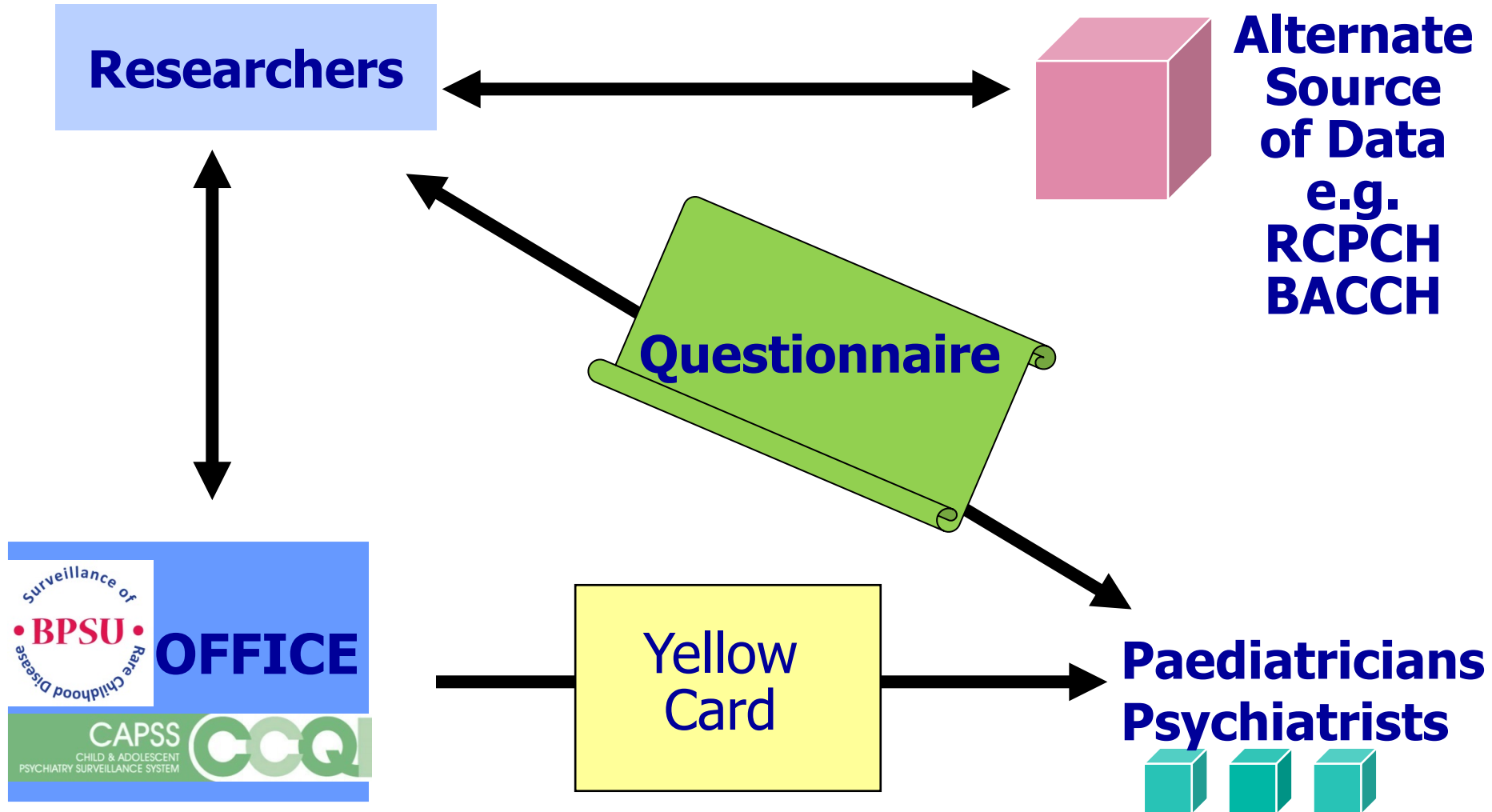

- Gender identity disorder
