IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF REFERRALS TO THE PSYCHIATRY LIAISON TEAM IN A BUSY ACUTE HOSPITAL

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BACKGROUND

The Psychiatry Liaison Team (PLT) provide psychiatric input for hospital inpatients.



We have observed difficulty with receiving inappropriate referrals.



There is poor understanding of the PLT role amongst other medical teams.



AIMS

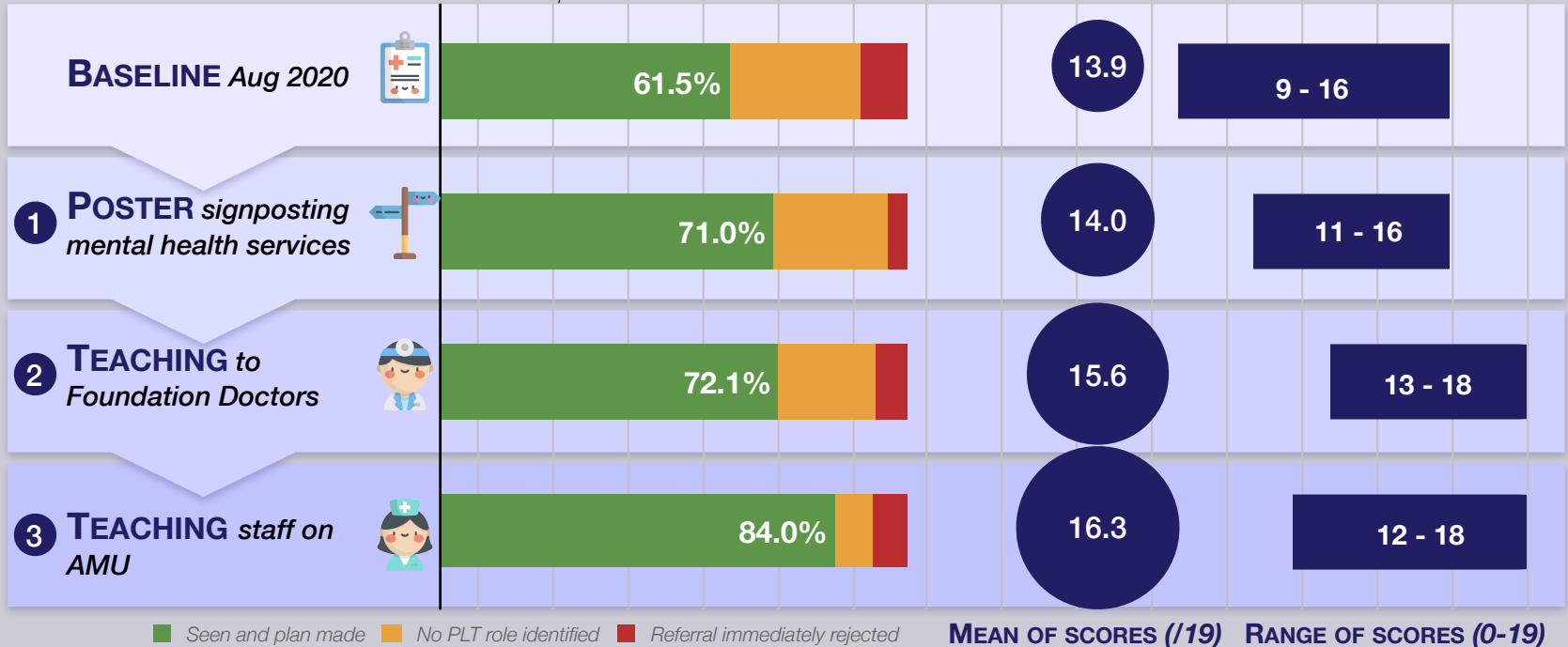
1. Reduce no. of inappropriate referrals by 50%
2. Improve junior doctors' understanding of PLT



CYCLES

Outcome of referrals made to PLT over 2 week period

Foundation doctors surveyed + tested 19-item scenario-based assessment



INAPPROPRIATE REFERRALS

BY PROFESSION 38% of referrals from nurses did not require PLT input

BY SITE 44% of referrals from AMU did not require PLT input

IMPACT Improve hospital-wide understanding of mental health services

END-GOAL Patients can be seen by the most appropriate team quicker

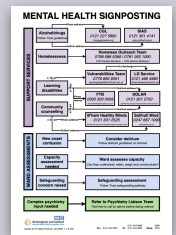


FIG. 2 SIGNPOSTING POSTER
