

↑ Access to Green and Blue Spaces


Trees cool cities and reduce air pollution

### Does Nonviolent direct action work? Yes

1984 Jane's Defence Weekly reports training exercises had been shelved because of political problems caused by the continued presence of the peace protestors.





1985 General Charles L. Donelly Jnr, Commander of the American Airforce in Europe, admitted that protestors had reduced by 25 per cent the frequency with which convoys were able to move outside Greenham.



### 4. DIRECT INTERVENTIONS: GREENPEACE STOP BOTTOM TRAWLER FISHING OFF CORNISH COAST



18 boulders of Portland limestone, each weighing between 500kg and 1,400kg, make it impossible for bottom-towed fishing gear to be dragged along the seabed. **Similar actions** elsewhere resulted in bottom trawling ban in marine
