- Starting with the solution, rather than the problem

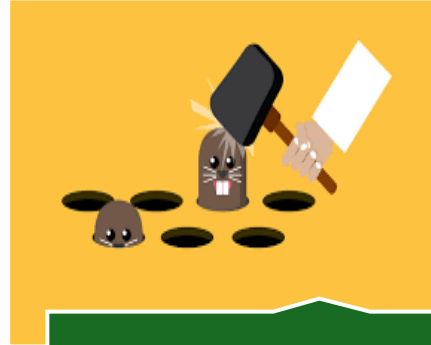
The top 5 reasons why medical leaders need to understand digital transformation
