1.8 Data quality & analysis plan	<p>Data quality and audit data for memory assessment services</p> <p>In England, data will be extracted from the Mental Health Services Dataset.</p> <p>In Wales data will be extracted from aggregated data forming part of Wales Performance data for NHS</p> <p>in Jersey, data will be aggregated and submitted in line with the metrics identified for England.</p> <p>Data quality and completeness have yet to be ascertained and this will be evaluated during analysis of the first tranche of data requested in 2026.</p> <p>Comments in the patient and carer questionnaires (if/ when used) are examined and any identifying information removed as they are entered. reported in comments which indicated an ongoing problem that the hospital should be informed about immediately, will be fed back during data collection, with anonymity preserved. All comments will be fed back to participating hospitals as soon as initial cleaning is complete so that they can immediately address issues identified.

Case adjustment

For previous rounds of audit, the Project Team explored the influence of sample demographics on hospital results. For example, the impact of gender, age and ethnicity on scores have been examined. Comparing the unadjusted and adjusted hospital scores, the differences were very small. This meant there were no meaningful adjustments to be made and therefore, all scores were left in an unadjusted format. This will be tested again for future data analysis.

Changes made to the data

During the process of quality assuring the data received, changes may be made:

- Across all audit tools, when it is possible to confidently identify data errors in comments returned, responses will be changed, and this change recorded. Where it is not possible to identify an error with complete confidence, no change is made.
- Duplicates identified in datasets will be removed.
- Where comments show eligibility criteria was not met (e.g., time period, completed diagnosis) casenotes will be removed.
- All identifying information in comments will be removed from carer/ patient questionnaires.
- Items will be removed from reporting where analysis or expert advice indicates that the data is not of sufficient quality.

Quantitative data cleaning and analysis is completed in IBM SPSS Statistics 21 by the Project Team. Qualitative data analysis is completed in Microsoft Excel using pre-agreed coding frameworks (informed by the data) and cross-checked by coders.

Waiting time

Access (as part of above)

- To reduce the average waiting time from referral to initial assessment, measured as the time between recorded date of referral and date of initial assessment for each patient.

Assessment:

- To increase the proportion of assessed patients with all essential pre-assessment components (eyesight, hearing, falls history, alcohol consumption, and smoking history) recorded as care activities.

Assessment:

- To increase the proportion of services with access to the Picture Archiving and Communication System to view structural imaging to diagnose dementia. A service will be considered to have PACS access if at least one assessed patient has a recorded structural imaging care activity during the reporting period.

Assessment quality

- To reduce variation between services in the reporting of dementia diagnosis type, measured by variation in the proportion of primary diagnoses by type across services.

Intervention

- To increase the proportion of patients receiving Cognitive Stimulation Therapy following a new diagnosis of dementia, measured as total number of patients per service with CST recorded as a care activity.

Post diagnostic support

- To increase the proportion of patients with a named Care Co-ordinator, measured as the total number of patients who have an Assigned Care

Professional on record.

- To increase the proportion of patients with a dementia care plan for post-diagnostic support, measured as the total number of patients per service who have a dementia care plan on record.
