Appendix B: Glossary of Key Terms

Access and Waiting Time (AWT) Standard: Children and Young People referred for an assessment or treatment of an eating disorder will access NICE concordant treatment within 1 week for urgent cases and 4 weeks for routine cases.

Adolescent-Focused Psychotherapy for Anorexia Nervosa (AFP-AN): AFP-AN is an individual therapy focused on eating symptoms in the context of common themes in adolescent development.

Aggregated Data: Data aggregation is a process where data from multiple sources (e.g. data submitted by each eating disorder team) is gathered and expressed in a summary form (e.g. by Trust, ICB, region or service type) for statistical analysis.

Anorexia Nervosa (AN): A person with AN limits how much they eat or drink due to fear of weight gain. It is not the same as anorexia, which means loss of appetite and is a symptom of illnesses such as depression and cancer.

Atypical Anorexia Nervosa: A person with Atypical Anorexia Nervosa will present similar to people with Anorexia Nervosa but one of the core features of Anorexia Nervosa will be absent e.g. extreme weight loss/low weight, fear of weight gain.

Atypical Bulimia Nervosa: A person with Atypical Bulimia Nervosa will present the same binge and purge behaviours as those with Bulimia Nervosa; however, the regularity of the episodes is far less frequent, or some other core feature is absent e.g. fear of weight gain.

Avoidant/Restrictive Food Intake Disorder (ARFID): A person with ARFID avoids certain foods or types of food, having restricted intake in terms of overall amount eaten, or both. The reason for food restriction is not due to concerns about body weight and shape.

Binge Eating Disorder (BED): A person with BED eats very large quantities of food without feeling like they're in control of what they're doing.

Body Mass Index (BMI): A method of adjusting someone's weight to take their height into consideration, since weight is height dependent. In Children, BMI needs to also be adjusted for age and sex.

Bulimia Nervosa (BN): Bulimia (or Bulimia Nervosa) involves a cycle of eating large quantities of food (binging) and then trying to compensate for that overeating through various means (purging).

Cognitive Behavioural Therapy for Eating Disorders (CBT-ED): Individual CBT-ED is a psychological therapy focussed on current problems and how to change thoughts and behaviours that maintain an eating disorder. This therapy may be recommended as part of the treatment for all kinds of eating disorders.

Cognitive Behavioural Therapy Ten (CBT-T): A brief (ten-session) form of CBT-ED.

Community service: Community services are outpatient services with the aim of providing accessible, localised care within the community (and outside of hospital).

Day patient service: Step-down care from inpatient treatment or an alternative to admission. Intensive day patient treatment is provided on at least four to five days a week.

Documented ARFID care pathway: A detailed plan that outlines the steps and processes for caring for individuals with ARFID specifically, rather than a general pathway for all eating disorders.

Documented Binge Eating Disorder care pathway: A detailed plan that outlines the steps and processes for caring for individuals with BED specifically, rather than a general pathway for all eating disorders.

First Episode Rapid Early Intervention for Eating Disorders (FREED): FREED is First Episode Rapid Early Intervention for Eating Disorders. It is a service model and care package for 16 to 25-year-olds who have had an eating disorder for three years or less, with a focus on the difficulties young people face during these years of their life.

Focal Psychodynamic Therapy (FPT): FPT is a form of therapy that encourages people to explore early events that may have affected their mental health and helps them find healthier ways to cope with negative emotions.

Inpatient service: Inpatient services are for people who can no longer be supported at home and need to be admitted to a psychiatric ward due to the severity of their eating disorder.

Integrated Care Board (ICB): ICBs are NHS organisations responsible for planning and commissioning health services for their local population.

Intensive community service: Intensive community treatment may include a brief period of outreach support provided by a community eating disorder service and/or increased frequency of community treatment to maintain momentum towards progress, including supervised mealtimes and support for families around meals, for an agreed period of time.

Maudsley Model of Anorexia Nervosa Treatment for Adults (MANTRA): A specialist integrative therapy specifically designed for the treatment of Anorexia Nervosa which aims to address the cognitive, emotional, relational and biological factors which tend to keep people stuck in their illness.

Mean: Mean is a measure of central tendency, most commonly referred to as the average. It represents the sum of all values in a dataset divided by the total number of values.

National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE): An independent organisation in the UK that provides national guidance and advice to improve the quality of health and social care.

NHS Futures dashboard: NHS Futures is a free, secure, online collaboration platform for everyone working in health and social care to connect, share knowledge, and work on projects across different organisations. NHS Futures hosts mental health data reporting dashboards, designed to help healthcare professionals, commissioners, and policymakers access, visualise, and interpret data related to mental health services across England.

NICE Guideline 69 (NG69): The NICE guideline for the recognition and treatment of eating disorders.

Night Eating Syndrome (NES): NES is characterised by excessive food intake in the evening or nighttime.

Outreach service: Outreach services include primary care, work around prevention and school/university outreach services.

Paired Outcome Measures: Outcome measures that are recorded at two time points or more during treatment time, e.g. start of treatment, follow-up second time point, or at the end of treatment.

Provider Collaboratives: Partnerships which bring two or more NHS Trusts to work together across multiple locations to deliver services at scale.

Purging Disorder: Purging disorders involves recurrent purging after normal or small amounts of food.

Specialist Supportive Clinical Management (SSCM): A psychotherapy that integrates elements of psychoeducation, CBT and psychodynamic therapy to facilitate a patient's understanding of their eating disorder and helps them to develop coping strategies that promote recovery.

Voluntary, Community and Social Enterprise (VCSE): An umbrella term encompassing a range of organisations that help deliver services, shape their design and advocate for the voice of service users, and carers.



Figure 2: Services provided and the percentage that are eating disorder specific, general with an eating disorder pathway, general with no eating disorder pathway, or other




Figure 3: Percentage of community, day patient and inpatient teams, provided by age group, that are an eating disorder specific service, a general service with an eating disorder pathway, a general service with no eating disorder pathway, or an other service





Figure 4: Percentage of outreach, intensive community and other teams, provided by age group, that are an eating disorder specific service, a general service with an eating disorder pathway, a general service with no eating disorder pathway, or an other service








Figure 10: Map of eating disorder services that treat Atypical Anorexia Nervosa

Figure 11: The percentage of teams treating Bulimia Nervosa, by region




Figure 12: Map of eating disorder services that treat Bulimia Nervosa

Figure 13: The percentage of teams treating Atypical Bulimia Nervosa, by region




Figure 14: Map of eating disorder services that treat Atypical Bulimia Nervosa




Figure 20: Map of eating disorder services treating Purging Disorder

Figure 21: The percentage of teams treating Night Eating Syndrome, by region





Figure 22: Map of eating disorder services treating Night Eating Syndrome





Figure 23: The percentage of teams treating Anorexia Nervosa, by service type





Figure 24: The percentage of teams treating Atypical Anorexia Nervosa, by service type





Figure 25: The percentage of teams treating Bulimia Nervosa, by service type





Figure 26: The percentage of teams treating Atypical Bulimia Nervosa, by service type





Figure 27: The percentage of teams treating Binge Eating Disorder, by service type





Figure 28: The percentage of teams treating ARFID, by service type







Figure 31: The percentage of teams using each exclusion criterion for accessing services, by service type





Figure 32: The percentage of community teams reporting primary reasons for waitlists (out of teams that reported having people on their waiting lists)





Figure 33: The average number of people, reported by services, on waiting list for treatment for an eating disorder in community services, by age and region





Figure 34: The average number of people, reported by services, on waiting list for an initial assessment and treatment for an eating disorder, by service type





Figure 37: The percentage of community adult teams that have staff members within each profession




Figure 38: The percentage of community CYP teams that have staff members within each profession





Figure 39: The percentage of community all age teams that have staff members within each profession

Figure 40: The percentage of day patient adult teams that have staff members within each profession





Figure 41: The percentage of day patient CYP teams that have staff members within each profession

Figure 42: The percentage of inpatient adult teams that have staff members within each profession






Figure 43: The percentage of inpatient CYP teams that have staff members within each profession





Figure 45: The percentage of teams reporting staff vacancies, by service type





Figure 46: The percentage of teams reporting primary reasons for staff vacancies, by region





Figure 47: The percentage of teams reporting primary reasons for staff vacancies, by service type





Figure 48: The average caseload of therapists, by region





Figure 49: The average caseload of therapist, by service type









Figure 53: Percentage of community adult teams in each region that have staff trained to deliver Maudsley Anorexia Nervosa Treatment for Adults (MANTRA), specialist supportive clinical management (SSCM), and eating-disorder-focused focal psychodynamic therapy (FPT)




Figure 56: Percentage of community CYP teams in each region that have staff trained to deliver Maudsley Anorexia Nervosa Treatment for Adults (MANTRA), specialist supportive clinical management (SSCM), and eating-disorder-focused focal psychodynamic therapy (FPT) (Note: these are NICE-recommended adult interventions and would not be expected to be delivered within CYP teams unless considered appropriate for someone with a longstanding disorder.)





Figure 57: Percentage of community CYP teams in each region that have staff trained to deliver cognitive behavioural therapy – ten (CBT-T), group cognitive behavioural therapy for eating disorders (CBT-ED), guided self-help and other psychotherapy




Figure 59: Percentage of community all age teams in each region that have staff trained to deliver Maudsley Anorexia Nervosa Treatment for Adults (MANTRA), specialist supportive clinical management (SSCM), and eating-disorder-focused focal psychodynamic therapy (FPT)





Figure 60: Percentage of community all age teams in each region that have staff trained to deliver adolescent-focused psychotherapy for anorexia nervosa (AFP-AN), CYP eating-disorder-focused family therapy (CYP FT ED), guided self-help and other psychotherapy




Figure 62: Percentage of teams that have staff trained to deliver Maudsley Anorexia Nervosa Treatment for Adults (MANTRA), specialist supportive clinical management (SSCM), and eating-disorder-focused focal psychodynamic therapy (FPT), by service type





Figure 63: Percentage of teams that have staff trained to deliver adolescent-focused psychotherapy for anorexia nervosa (AFP-AN), CYP eating-disorder-focused family therapy (CYP FT ED), guided self-help and other types of interventions, by service type



Figure 66: Percentage of teams that have a protocol for shared care of disordered eating behaviour in the context of other psychiatric comorbidities, by service type




Figure 67: Percentage of teams that have a protocol for shared care of disordered eating behaviour in the context of other physical comorbidities, by service type




Figure 68: Percentage of teams that have a protocol for shared care of disordered eating behaviour in the context of neurodivergence, by service type





Figure 69: Percentage of teams that have a protocol for shared care of disordered eating behaviour in perinatal women, by service type

Figure 70: Percentage of teams that routinely collect patient and parent reported outcome measures, by region




Figure 71: Percentage of teams that routinely collect clinician reported outcomes, physical health outcomes, and paired outcome measures, by region





Figure 72: Percentage of teams that routinely collect: outcomes before and after transition from a CYP service to an adult service, quality of life, mortality, and other outcome measures, by region

Figure 73: Percentage of teams that routinely collect patient and parent reported outcome measures, by service type




Figure 74: Percentage of teams that routinely collect clinician reported outcomes, physical health outcomes, and paired outcome measures, by service type





Figure 75: Percentage of teams that routinely collect outcomes before and after transition from a CYP service to an adult service, quality of life, mortality, and other outcome measures, by service type

Figure 76: Percentage of teams that report using medical stability, nutritional stability and psychological readiness to determine whether a patient is ready to be discharged, by region





Figure 77: Percentage of teams that report using progress towards goals, reaching end of treatment and other reasons to determine whether a patient is ready to be discharged, by region

Figure 78: Percentage of teams that report using medical stability, nutritional stability and psychological readiness to determine whether a patient is ready to be discharged, by service type





Figure 79: Percentage of teams that report using progress towards goals, reaching end of treatment and other reasons to determine whether a patient is ready to be discharged, by service type
