

## The Review Cycle

Teams undertake a comprehensive review cycle based on the standards, which includes:

- Self review:** Provide services the opportunity to self-reflect on the quality of care provided, marking 'met', 'partly met' or 'not met' against the standards and gathering feedback from surveys.
- Peer review:** Provides a platform for promoting and encouraging best practice, network and constructive communication. Peer review teams are made up of 4-5 people including professional from difference services and people with lived experience.
- Local report:** Services receive a detailed report, highlighting good practice and recommendations for development.
