

## Team Membership to Community CCQI Networks - EIPN

To be accepted for and to maintain membership to the Early Intervention in Psychosis Network (EIPN) as one team, services must meet the following criteria.

Where there is more than one team base or there are 'sub teams' working in different geographical areas **all parts of the service must:**

- Come under the remit of the same Trust or provider organisation.
- Work to the same operational policy and admission criteria (or equivalent documents).
- Conduct service development meetings together on a regular basis (it is understood that these meetings may only be attended by leadership staff).
- Have at least one member of the senior management/leadership team working across all sites/ sub teams.

In addition, where there is more than one team base or there are 'sub teams' working in different geographical areas it is expected that all parts of the service **do at least one of the following:**

- Have weekly team meetings to discuss referrals and caseloads.
- Have regular whole team meetings to discuss service development.
- Have a system for reviewing new referrals and high-risk cases daily

## Peer reviews

The amount of time allocated for peer reviews will be increased for EIP teams with 'sub teams' working in different geographical areas as follows:

- 1 location = 1 day
- 2-3 locations = 1 ½ days
- 4-5 locations = 2 days

## Membership fees

The amount of work needed to review an EIP team increases as the number of 'sub teams' working in different geographical areas goes up and therefore membership fees will be higher for these larger teams. The 2021 membership fees will be as follows:

- 1 location = £2,155 for one year or £5,820 for three years
- 2-3 locations = £3,235 for one year or £8,730 for three years
- 4-5 locations = £4,310 for one year or £11,640 for three years
