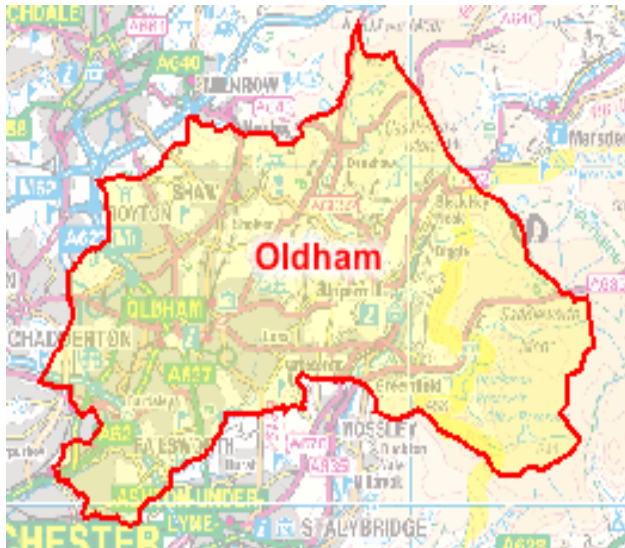

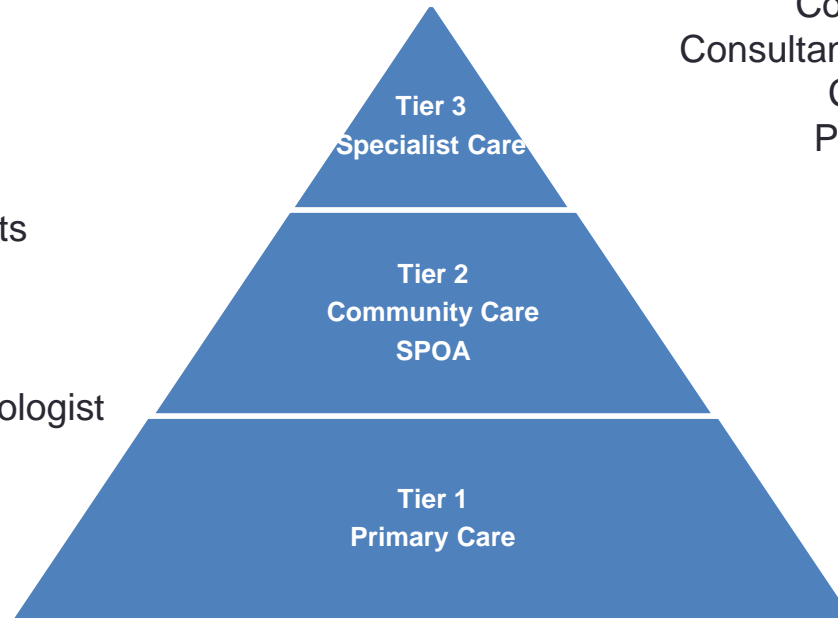

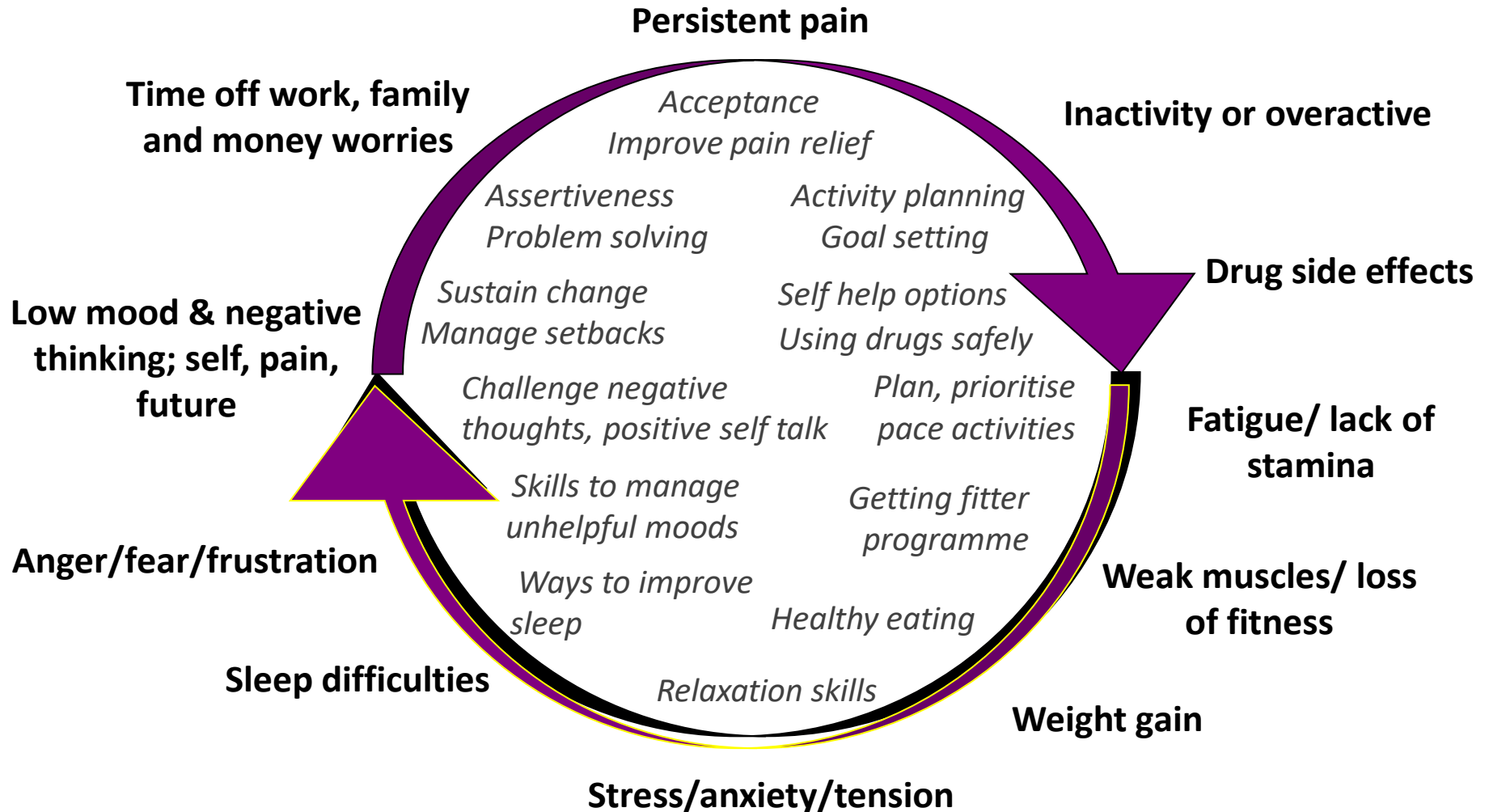

Mental illness, suicidal thoughts and opioids

- 102 initial assessment forms surveyed
- 41% reported past or current mental health difficulties
- 24% recent thoughts of self harm or suicide
- 2/3 on prescribed opioids

Patient Self Efficacy Questionnaire and Clinical Global Impression I scale

	Number of patients	Any improvement	Clinically significant improvement
PSEQ Q1 17-18	142	72%	52% > 10 PSEQ
PSEQ Q1 18-19	108	77%	66% > 10 PSEQ
CG1 Q1 17-18	159	82%	59% much/ v much improved
CGI Q1 18-19	137	73%	54% much/ v much improved

- Compared with 2014/15 the 2016/17 year end position showed recurrent efficiencies of £750,000 primarily through a significant reduction in interventional procedures.
