# Ground Rules and Expectations

To keep the group safe, professional, and collaborative, please follow these principles:

**Maintain confidentiality in line with organisational and professional principles**



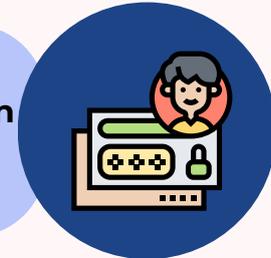
**Only upload documents you have permission to share**



**Your profile information (name, email, job title, service) is visible to other APPTS group members**



**APPTS cannot reset your password, please keep your login details safe**



**Posts are visible to all APPTS KnowledgeHub members, including staff from other services and partner organisations**



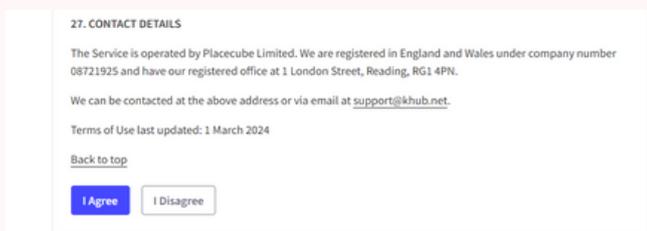
**Use respectful, professional language at all time**



# Signing Up to KnowledgeHub

## Step 1 — Create Your Knowledge Hub Account

- Go to [www.khub.net](http://www.khub.net).
- Select 'Register' and enter the following:
  - Your full name
  - Your email address
  - Your organisation and job title
  - (This information is required so we can verify you as an APPTS member.)

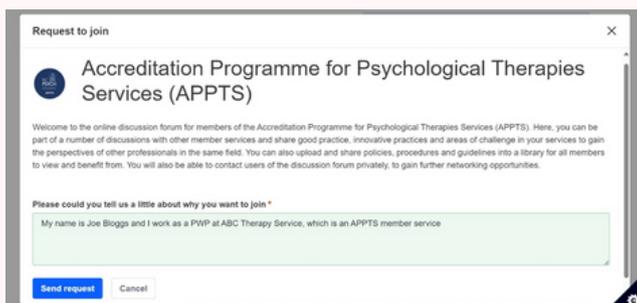

## Step 3 — Find the APPTS Group

- Use the search bar at the top of the page.
- Type "APPTS" and look for the group titled Accreditation Programme for Psychological Therapies.
- Open the group page.

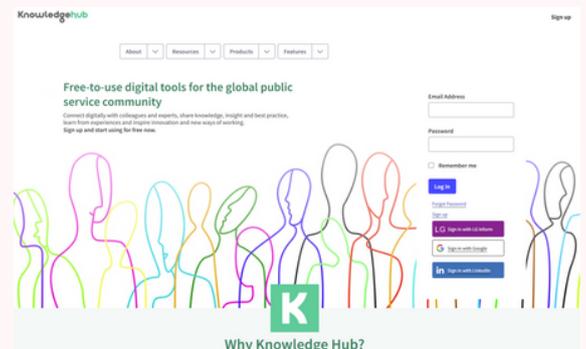

Once approved, you will have full access to:

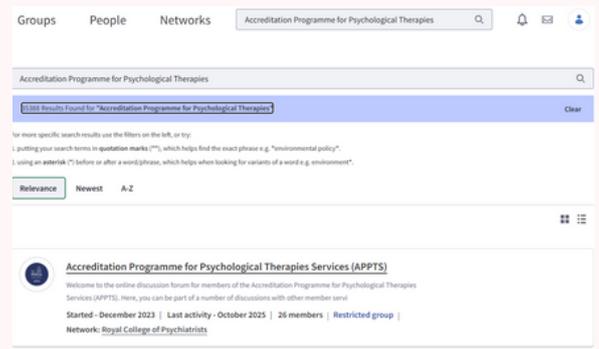
- Discussion forums

## Step 4 — Request to Join

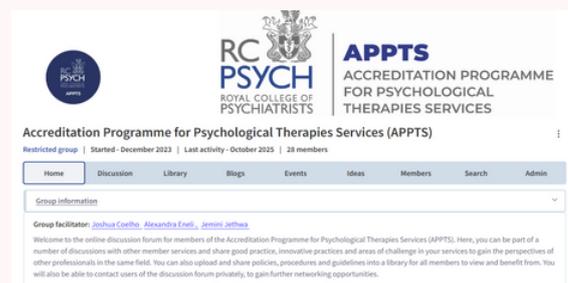
Click Request to Join.

- Your service name

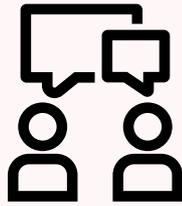

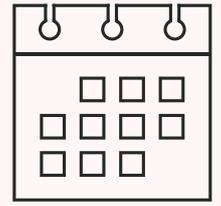
# Using KnowledgeHub

## Posting on the Forum



- Visit the Discussion tab to start a post
- Keep your question or topic clear and concise.
- Use keywords to help others find your post later.
- Avoid including identifiable service user information.
- Check existing threads before posting to avoid duplicates.

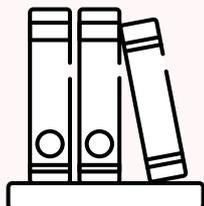
## Finding Events



- Visit the Events tab on the group page.
- Click on an event to see details, including booking links.
- Check back regularly as new events are added throughout the year.

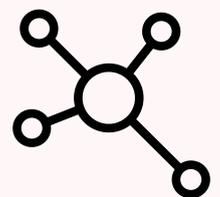

## Using the Library



- Use the search bar or browse folders.
- Download files via the three-dot menu.
- When uploading, always set visibility to **Group only**.
- Add tags to help other members locate resources.

## Connecting with Members



- Use the Members tab to search by name or organisation.
- Click on a member profile to view contact details.
- Only include information on your own profile that you are comfortable sharing.

# Troubleshooting

## I didn't receive a verification email

- Check your junk or spam folder.
- Add "@khub.net" to your safe-sender list.
- If still missing, request a new verification email from the login page.

## I can't upload documents

- Check that the file size is within KnowledgeHub limits.
- Ensure you have selected File Upload within the group library.
- Confirm the document visibility is set to Group.

## I forgot my password

- Use the Forgot Password link on the login page.
- APPTS cannot reset your password for you

## My request to join hasn't been approved yet

- Approvals can take up to 2 working days.
- Ensure your job title and service name were included in your request description.

## I can't find the APPTS group

- Ensure you are searching for "APPTS" or "RCPsych APPTS".
- Confirm you are logged in to your KnowledgeHub account.
- Contact APPTS if the group does not appear.

### Data Protection and Privacy

When you join KnowledgeHub, the profile information you choose to provide such as your name, email address, phone number, job title, and service is **visible only to other members of the closed APPTS KnowledgeHub group**. This information is not accessible to the public. You may decide how much contact information to include on your profile.

Please ensure that any documents or posts you share do not contain confidential or identifiable information about service users or staff, and that you have permission from your service before uploading any policies, guidelines, or internal documents.

# Best Practice Guide

## Communication

- Keep posts clear, respectful, and relevant to APPTS and neuropsychiatric services.
- Use descriptive titles for forum threads to help others locate information.
- Before starting a new thread, check if the topic has already been discussed.

## Sharing Resources

- Upload documents only when you have permission from your service to share them.
- Use accurate titles, descriptions, and tags so others can find resources easily.
- Ensure uploaded content does not include confidential or identifiable information.

## Engagement

- Respond to questions where you can add value or share relevant experience.
- Use the networking features to connect with colleagues across services.
- Keep your profile up to date so others can contact you if needed.

## Professional Conduct

- Maintain confidentiality at all times.
- Follow your organisational policies and professional codes of practice.
- Avoid posting anything that may compromise service user privacy or organisational integrity.

## Staying Updated

- Check the Events and Library tabs regularly.
  - Turn on notifications for discussions you follow.
  - Contact the APPTS team if you need support or spot an issue within the group.
-
