People with complex mental health problems are one of the most marginalised groups in society and among the least able to advocate for themselves. Centre for Mental Health's briefing report on long stay mental health rehabilitation facilities has identified a number of worrying issues related to the quality of care they offer. Most of these are a direct consequence of years of disinvestment in local

rehabilitation services and a historic lack of policy to guide NHS commissioners and trusts in what is required to support successful


