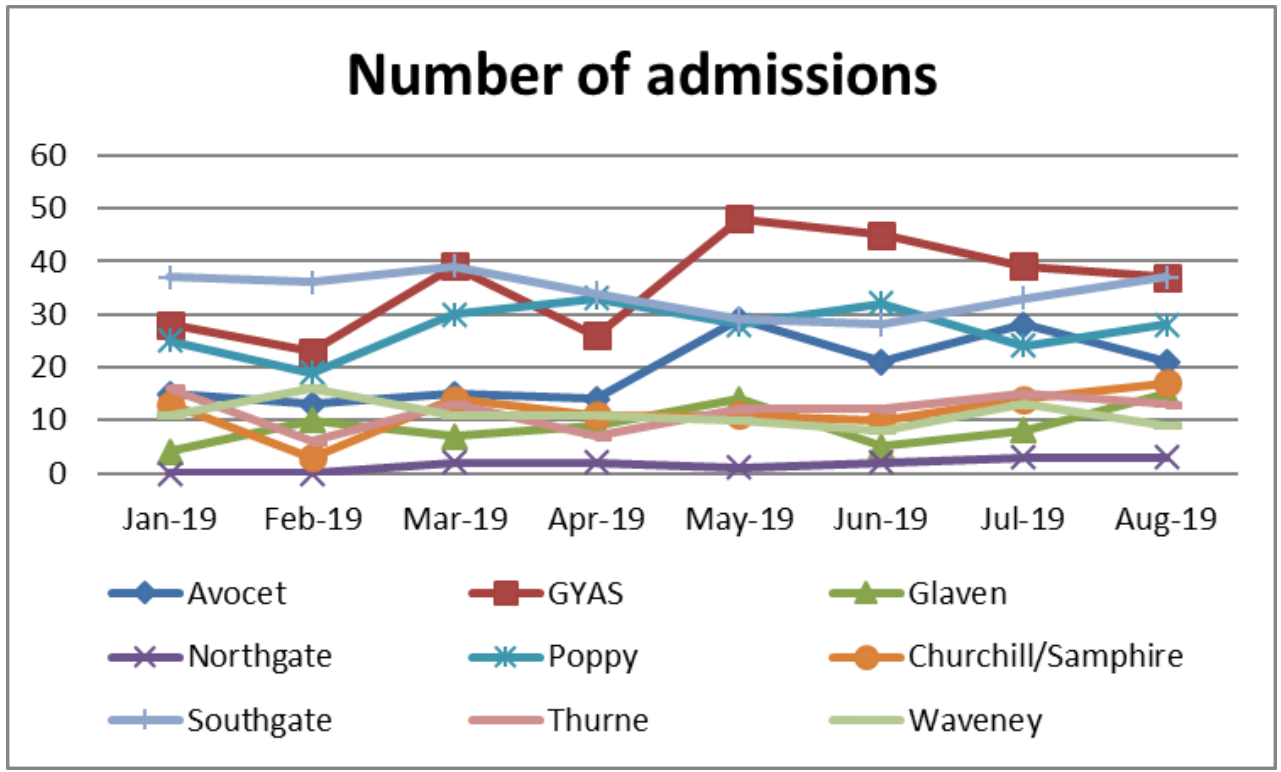

- Age range 18 +



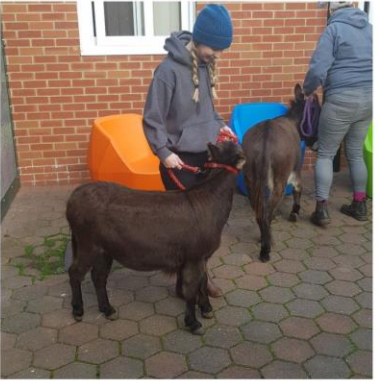

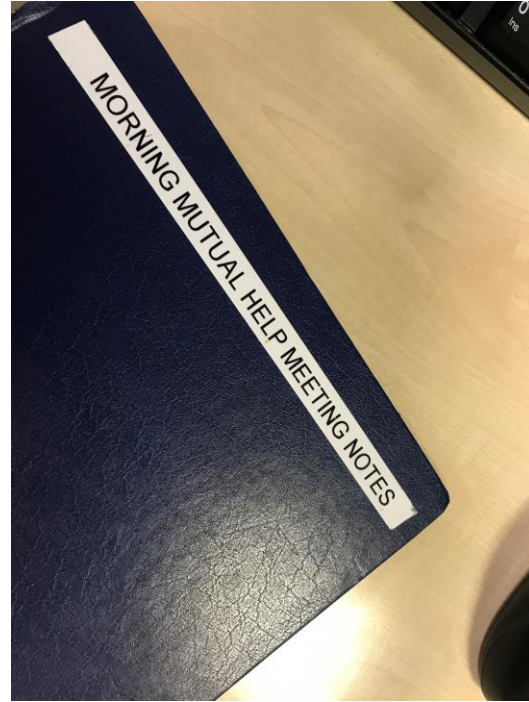

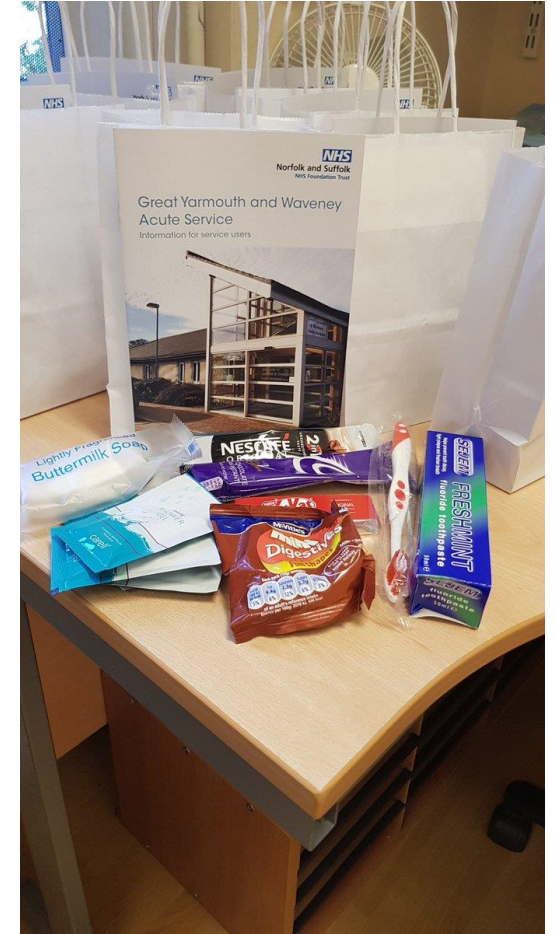

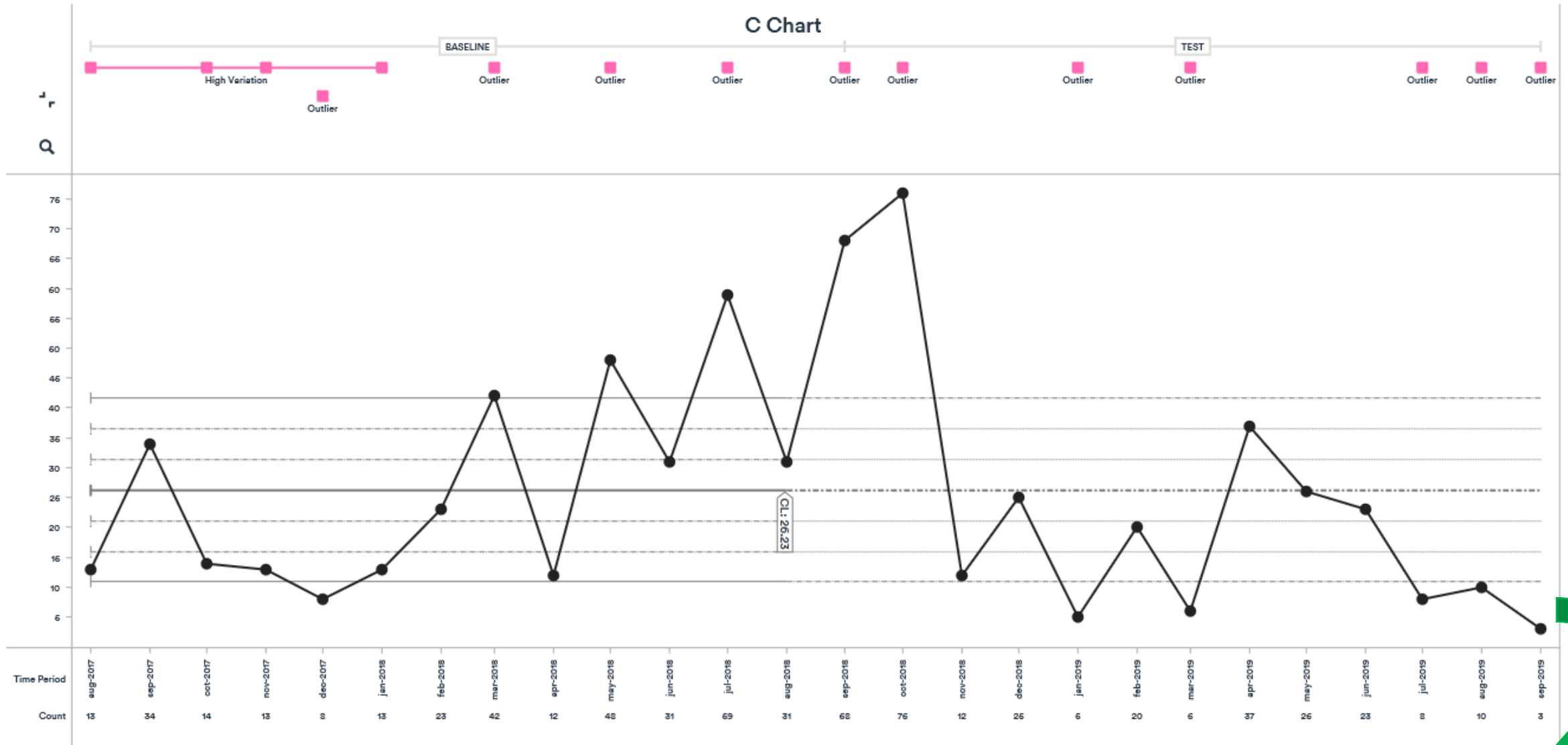
