Call for Posters – Closing Date for Abstract Submissions 22nd October

The Executive Committee of the Eastern Division and the "Enhancing Foundation Experience in Psychiatry" of Health Education East of England invite submissions for poster presentation at the Autumn Conference (online event) of the Eastern Division on the 4th November 2021.

There will be separate prizes for the best 3 posters in each of the 4 categories:

- A. Medical Students
- B. FY Trainees
- C. General Medical
- D. Multidisciplinary

The Abstract

- Abstracts should be in Word format and no more than one side of an A4 paper.
- The title of the poster should be in bold. The title must not contain abbreviations.
- Give the name, grade, email and employing organisation of the presenting author.
- Give name and grade e.g. medical student, FY2, CT3 of all co-authors
- Where relevant, please state aims, methods, results, discussion and conclusions.
- References, tables and appendices are **not** required.
- Please email your abstract to: a.abraham4@nhs.net and CC moinul.mannan@rcpsych.ac.uk with the subject reference (ED-04.11.21-Name of first author-Title of poster).
- **The closing date** for submission of abstracts is **Friday 22nd October 2021**.

The Poster

- Once your abstract is accepted you must register for the Conference and prepare your poster.
- The poster will be added on our webpage for delegates to view on **04.11.2021**.
- The poster should be **A4 and in PDF format** and in **PORTRAIT layout NOT LANDSCAPE**.
- The authors of the **best three posters in categories A, B and C will be invited to give a 6 minute oral PowerPoint presentation** on 04.11.2021.
