Call for Posters Closing Date for Submissions 4th October

The Executive Committee of the Eastern Division invite submissions for poster presentation at the Autumn Conference of the Eastern Division on the 25th October 2024.

There will be prizes for the best poster in each of the 4 categories:

- A. Medical Students
- B. FY Trainees
- C. General Medical
- D. Multidisciplinary

The Abstract

- Abstracts should be in Word format and no more than one side of an A4 paper. Abstracts longer than one page will be returned to the author for shortening.
- The title of the poster should be in bold. The title must not contain abbreviations.
- Give the name, email, contact number and employing organisation of the presenting author.
- Give name and grade e.g. medical student, FY2, CT3 of all co-authors;
- Where relevant, please state aims, methods, results, discussion and conclusions.
- References, tables and appendices are not required.

- **The closing date** for submission of abstracts is **Friday 4th October 2024** to be included in abstract booklet. Later submissions may be accepted but will not be included in the booklet.

The Poster

- If accepted, bring the poster to the conference on **25.10.2024**.
- The poster should be **A0** (118 x 84cm) or less size and **PORTRAIT layout NOT LANDSCAPE**.
- Velcro and adhesive will be provided.
- Hand-outs for distribution to delegates will be appreciated.
- The presenter is responsible for collecting the poster at the end of the conference.
- Posters can be on case reports, new research, audit, literature reviews, and other topics of clinical significance. The Medical students and FY trainees are invited to submit posters from any speciality in their respective categories.
- The posters will be judged on the day. The winners in each category will be invited to give a **6 minute oral presentation** on **25.10.2024**. **All authors are encouraged to have a Powerpoint presentation ready on a memory stick.**
