



## RCPSYCH IN SCOTLAND RESEARCH PRIZE 2021

### Research Prize

A prize of £500 is available and the winner will be expected to present their work at a future RCPsychiS webinar or meeting in 2022. The aim of this prize to reward recently completed clinical research in the field of psychiatry.

### Judging

The Chair, Vice Chair and one representative working in Academic Psychiatry will make up the panel.

### Criteria

This should be a paper submitted to, or published in, a Peer Reviewed journal in 2020/21. Online publications will be accepted and where possible please provide the DOI (Digital Object Identifier) number assigned for the paper in its final (i.e. publication) format. Where the paper-version is delayed, the same paper cannot be entered again in a subsequent year. Applicants should alert the reviewers to additional online data (directly-related to the paper and published by the journal) which they wish to be considered.

Open to all categories of membership in good standing (Members, Specialist Associates, Affiliates, Pre-Membership Psychiatric Trainees, etc.) of the RCPsych in Scotland other than Fellows, who have been in their present category of membership for less than ten years. Allowance may be made for members who have worked less than full time for more than ten years, so long as the total time is equivalent to less than ten years.
