Competition Guidelines:

- Open to RCPsych in Scotland members and friends/family of members.
- Submissions must be received by Friday, 22nd March.

How to Enter:

- 1. **Create:** Design a tartan that embodies Mental Health and the unique identity of the RCPsych in Scotland. Participants can use paper, graph paper, with paint, felt tip, wax crayon, or electronic means of design. Experts at our chosen design company will be available to translate the design into a strict tartan specification.
- 2. **Explain:** Provide a brief concept/rationale behind your design, showcasing the inspiration and thought process.
- 3. **Submit:** Email your design to <u>scotland@rcpsych.ac.uk</u> before the deadline. Entries will be displayed in the College in Scotland for people to enjoy.

Judging Criteria:

- Creativity and Originality
- Representation of Mental Health Themes
- Alignment with RCPsych in Scotland and its Values
- Concept/Rationale Explanation

Winners Prize:

Your tartan design will be officially adopted by the Royal College of Psychiatrists in Scotland and registered with the Scottish Register of Tartan. Receive a certificate of recognition along with a commemorative quaich.

Let your creativity flow and be part of a milestone celebration! Your design will become an integral part of the College's history.
