THE TRENT DIVISION POSTER PRESENTATION PRIZES

The Trent Division has established annual prizes for the best poster presentations in one of the following topics; **quality improvement, audit or research** by Student Associates, FY1-2, CT1-3 trainees and ST4-6 trainees (and specialty grade doctors).

First Prize: £100 plus certificate (Student Associate/FY1-2)

£100 plus certificate (CT1-3)

£100 plus certificate (ST4-6/specialty grade doctor)

Second Prize: £50 plus certificate (Student Associate/FY1-2)

£50 plus certificate (CT1-3)

£50 plus certificate (ST4-6/specialty grade doctor)

Admission Fees:

Short-listed Student Associate/FY1&2 entrants will receive complimentary admission to the Trent Division Annual Conference.

Shortlisted trainees CT1-3/ST4-6/specialty grade doctors will be required to pay for admission to the Trent Division Annual Conference.

Frequency: Annually

Eligible: Student Associates, Trainees and specialty grade doctors working in any specialty or sub-specialty of psychiatry within the Trent Division are eligible to enter.

Where Presented: Trent Division Annual Conference

Regulations:

- i. Entrants should submit an electronic PDF copy of their poster and abstract of approximately 500 words.
- ii. A judging panel will determine the number of posters to be displayed and successful entrants will be invited to display their poster (maximum size A0) at the Trent Division Annual Conference.
- iii. First and Second Prizes will be awarded for the best poster presentation in each category (Student Associate/FY-1-2, CT1-3, ST4-6/Specialty grade doctor) relevant to any field of psychiatry.
- iv. Up to 3 first place entrants, 1 from each category (Student Associate/FY1-2, CT1-3, ST4-6/Specialty grade doctor), will be selected to give a 7 minute presentation plus 3 minutes for questions at the Trent Division Annual Conference. The first place entrants will be notified 4 weeks prior to the Conference in order to have time to prepare the presentation. The first place entrants will also receive complimentary admission to the conference.
- v. The remaining entrants will be offered the chance to take part in the Trent Division Poster Presentation Prize at the conference where the judging panel will decide on up to 3 second places, 1 from each category (Student Associate/FY1-2, CT1-3, ST4-6/Specialty grade doctor).
- vi. All short-listed entrants will need to bring along a poster to display at the conference.

Closing Date: The Poster Presentation Prize will be advertised throughout the Division each year and entries should be submitted by **01 October.**
