Call for Posters – Closing Date for Submissions 2nd May

The Executive Committee of the Eastern Division and the "Enhancing Foundation Experience in Psychiatry" of Health Education East of England invite submissions for poster presentation at the Spring Conference of the Eastern Division on the 17th May 2018.

There will be separate prizes for the best 3 posters in each of the 4 categories:

- A. Medical Students
- B. FY Trainees
- C. General Medical
- D. Multidisciplinary

The Abstract

- Abstracts should be in Word format and no more than one side of an A4 paper. Abstracts longer than one page will be returned to the author for shortening.
- The title of the poster should be in bold. The title must not contain abbreviations.
- Include name and grade e.g. medical student, FY2 of the presenting author and all co-authors; and email, contact number and name of the presenting author's employing organisation.
- Where relevant, please state aims, methods, results, discussion and conclusions.
- References, tables and appendices are not required.

- **The closing date for submission of abstracts is Weds 2nd May 2018 to be included in abstract booklet.** Later submissions may be accepted but will not be included in the booklet.

- The poster should be A0 (118 x 84cm) or less size and portrait layout.
- Velcro and adhesive will be provided.
- Hand-outs for distribution to delegates will be appreciated.
- The presenter is responsible for collecting the poster at the end of the conference.
- The authors of the **best three posters in categories A, B and C will be invited to give a 6 minute oral power point presentation** on 17.05.2018. All authors are encouraged to have a power point presentation ready on a memory stick.
