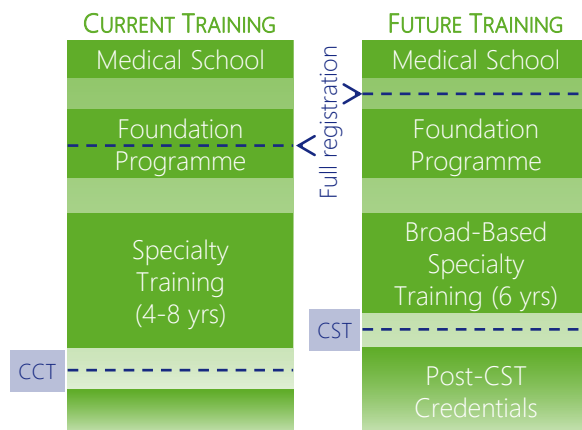

URGENT UPDATE FOR ALL TRAINEES

WHAT IS IT?

The Shape of Training Review is a comprehensive review of postgraduate medical education that will impact future training pathways for all specialties. It recommends a broad training of no longer than 6 years beyond Foundation Programme, established in 'themes' and culminating in award of a *Certificate of Specialist Training (CST)* at appointment to a consultant post. Credentialing will be required for further specialisation post-CST.

The outcome of this review has *far-reaching implications* but you have the opportunity to influence them by making your voice heard now. The Academy of Medical Royal Colleges (AoMRC) are currently mapping areas within each specialty where the delivery of doctors' training could be more generalised to better meet the current and future needs of patients. Your input is vitally needed so that your views can be understood, for example as to the perceived impact of the possible shortening of training, sub-speciality training and credentialing. The PTC aims to respond to this mapping process by the end of August 2015.
