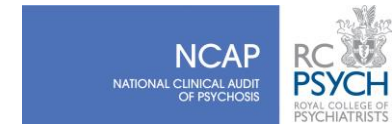

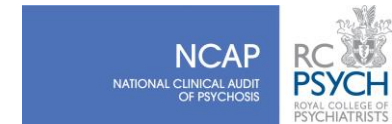


Case Note Audit Questionnaire – Analysis Plan

Analysis to be conducted on all standards at national, Health Board and team level. Team reports will include analysis of all data collected.

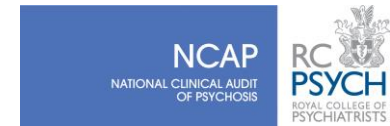

S4	Service users with first episode psychosis who have not responded adequately to or tolerated treatment with at least two antipsychotic drugs are offered clozapine.
