# Data collection tool for CCGs: Urgent and emergency mental health care and intensive home treatment for children and young people

This questionnaire describes the services comprising the 24/7 pathway for urgent and emergency mental health care and intensive home treatment for children and young people presenting in crisis. One tool should be completed for the entire geographically commissioned comprehensive pathway. Data should be for collected in relation to children and young people from age 0 to under 18 years.

This important voluntary survey, commissioned by NHS England, is intended to help commissioners and service providers to identify key strengths and gaps locally, benchmark performance, and drive local quality improvement.

**Guidance:** This questionnaire seeks to collect data for urgent & emergency mental health care and intensive home treatment for children and young people in the local area, including local alternatives to admission. The data should cover a footprint of one or more CCG areas and describe the service offer available 24 hours, 365 days per year. In some cases, this will be provided by more than one team.

We would be grateful if one tool is completed for each commissioning footprint. Returns should not include the wider general community NHS CAMH services.

*NB Each specific dedicated team is asked to complete a supplementary questionnaire comprising the urgent & emergency mental health (UEC MH) care team or Intensive Home Treatment (IHT) pathway for CYP.*
